OVERVIEW

This PLG is for the 2024 school year, approximately from January-April. The PLG meetings will be staggered with in-person and virtual meetings. With 3 face to face meetings, and virtual meetings equal to another day, this PLG will provide 4 days of TEAMS PD credit from AMSTI Affiliate, Firia Labs, or 4 days of CEU credit for those not pursuing the TEAMS program.

The focus of this PLG will be on the Computational Thinking strand of the <u>Alabama</u> <u>Digital Literacy and Computer Science Course of Study (2018)</u>. The DLCS standards are required to be taught by teachers in all subject areas. The Computational Thinking strand focuses on problem solving through the process of breaking problems into component parts, identifying key pieces of information, and using that information to solve the problems. Therefore, this training is applicable to all subjects including computer science, mathematics, and science.

Participants who complete the requirements will have access to check out a class set of CodeX from ATiM in Region 4.
